Joining up implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the Paris Agreement

This high-level event will gather national policy makers and non-state actors to discuss how they can advance their Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) to the Paris Agreement and their Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in an integrated manner. Highlights from a forthcoming WRI-GIZ paper -- building on experience from the EU and 13 other countries to explore policy options for a "joined-up" implementation -- will inform the discussion. Speakers will also present two tools for mapping these NDC-SDG links – WRI's Climate Watch NDC-SDG database, and DIE and SEI's NDC-SDG Connections Tool.
